Although the United Nations is pulling out by June 30 this year, most of us parents are not going back because of the threats on our lives.

The presence of the United Nations is a little sign of economic assistance. Realizing the fact the UN is pulling out, it is very difficult for parents to take care of the necessities of life in our present condition. The cost of living at the camp and in Ghana now is so high that we live one day at a time.

Therefore, we are depending on you solely to assist us with our children. We are still going to remain on the camp until the end of the year, hoping that by then, we will be resettled.

If it meets your approval, we would like to put forward to you our plans to send some African suits and shoes for sale by you. We are also looking at the possibility of the sale of water, both drinking and ordinary use, so that we would be able to sustain ourselves, with your help.

Some of our immediate needs are schools stationery, toiletries, (bath soap, toothbrushes, paste) etc. We would be highly appreciative if we could receive this help also.

We like to assure you that, we are constantly in prayers with you and for you.

May our good Lord continue to bless and keep you.
